Finally, in the "study" section, essays cover issues related both to early modern textual practice-the use of historical source materials in Shakespeare's writing, questions of multiple authorship, and the issue of early modern style and kinds of drama-and to more modern scholarly practice, such as the role of Shakespeare in the New Bibliography and the New Historicism.
